

Public Meeting Notice
Application Review and Environmental Concerns
Ash St. Pump Station, Force Main and Gravity Sewer Project
Silver Grove, KY

Sanitation District No. 1 (SD1) of Northern Kentucky has applied to the Kentucky Division of Water's Department of Environmental Protection, Water Infrastructure Branch for a low-interest loan from the Clean Water State Revolving Fund, which is funded in part by a grant to Kentucky from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, to finance the Ash Street Pump Station, Force Main and Gravity Sewer Project. The following is a description of the project:

SD1 will be constructing a new pump station in the City of Silver Grove with a capacity to pump seven million gallons of wastewater to SD1's treatment plant per day. The project also involves the construction of 28,000 linear feet of 20 inch diameter force main pipe along the Four Mile Road corridor (KY 547) between the City of Silver Grove and the Riley Road Pump Station located at the intersection of KY 547 and the AA Highway (KY 9). Smaller sections of force main and gravity sewer pipe will be installed in and around Silver Grove between Industrial Ave. and Ash St. The project will consist of creek crossings, directional drilling of a wetland, construction near historical structures and the installation of air release valves.

The Kentucky Division of Water will hold a public meeting on Tuesday, Oct. 15, 2013 at 7 p.m. at the Alexandria Courthouse located at 8352 East Main Street in Alexandria, KY. The purpose of the meeting is to allow the public to review and comment on proposed activities, potential impacts and the project alternatives that were considered. SD1 will compile all public comments and forward them to the Kentucky Division of Water for review.
