St. John Council Minutes June 12, 2024 7:00 PM

Nancy called this meeting to order. Vicar Dave, Lewis Heiert, Sylvia Tarvin, Emily Knight, Sue Heiert, Dennis Heiert, Nancy Enzweiler, and Taylor Gillespie are present.

Vicar Dave shared a Devotion from Isaiah

Lewis made a motion to accept the agenda and Sylvia seconded this motion.

Nancy shared that \$47.03 is a remaining balance of the Mission Investment Fund. Karen Castle will need to cancel the account with the Mission Investment Fund.

Dennis made a motion to cancel the account with the Mission Investment Fund and Lewis seconded it.

Nancy discussed a \$900 discrepancy written by Melanie Pelle.

Movers cost during the carpet installation was \$720.

Dennis brought to our attention that instead of two Fuel checks/costs, it should be one for signs and one for fuel and that they are not both fuel costs as listed on the second page of the Reconciliation Report.

Nancy asked Vicar Dave if he had any questions at this time and he did not.

Lewis made a motion that we accept the secretary report and Sylvia seconded this motion.

Taylor made a motion to accept the notes from our last council meeting and Sue seconded this motion.

Vicar Dave shared what he has been doing as part of his internship and what he has been doing with members. He gave us a business card and shared how he could use them. Vicar Dave will be at church for the next Food Pantry on June 24th and he will be available by appointment. He will be at church sporadically and does not have set office hours.

We discussed the leak in the basement of the church and we still need to learn where the water is coming in from. It may have something to do with the cracked concrete outside.

Landscaping cost is \$2300 with Dawson Carder.

Sue made a motion to accept this \$2300 offer from Dawson Carder and Sylvia seconded this motion.

Dennis is working on getting bids for the concrete work.

Old Business - UV protection to help protect the carpet is something that Lewis will look into before our next meeting. The printer installation will take place on June 17th from roughly 9:00 - 10:30 AM.

We discussed the welcome events for Vicar Dave that we have in place and more ideas. We would like to include the church picnic in September as one of these welcoming events.

Lewis nominates Emily Knight to be secretary and she accepts. Lewis made a motion for Emily Knight to be secretary and Taylor seconded this motion.

We are working on an Internship Committee to evaluate and support Vicar Dave throughout his internship process. We need 3-5 people to be on this committee. Nancy will chair this committee and Emily has made the commitment to be on this committee. It cannot contain all council members, so we will be reaching out to more members. We will meet once a month as part of this committee and it may be virtual meetings.

Vicar Dave let us know that he is willing to meet with members or non-members that might need a formal introduction or some form of communication from him, specifically. We discussed a few names and we may get a list of churches nearby to get the word out.

Nancy asked Vicar Dave if he would write something in this newsletter (about himself) and he said yes. We all shared our experiences with St. John's. The amount of years that these council members have been associated with this church in some way is remarkable!

Dennis made a motion to adjourn this meeting and Taylor seconded this motion.
